Submission of Coursework:

- 1. Educators should follow the guidelines for electronic input of data (Annex 2) for each interactive form
- 2. A summary of all interactive forms to be used for the above examinations is at *Annex 3*.
- 3. The documents as listed below at **3.1**, **3.4** and **3.5** MUST be submitted in 2 copies (Original + 1 copy). The original forms **3.4** and **3.5** must be inserted in the coursework/s to be submitted.
 - 3.1 Certificate of Authenticity (*Group*)HSC 9396/04 and SC 5016/02 (*The Progress Record Sheet/s for SC 5016/02 and HSC 9396/04 must be submitted separately to the MES*).
 - 3.2 Certificate of Authenticity (*Individual*) HSC 9396/02 (to be affixed with the coursework)
 - 3.3 Front cover of Activity coursework must be properly labeled *if any* (e.g *Hill Walking* to be affixed with the coursework)
 - 3.4 Action Plan Cover Sheet ('A' Level 9396/02)
 - 3.5 Progress Record Sheet for ('A' Level 9396/02)

The Educators must ensure that all the candidates' courseworks/materials being submitted tally with the numerical quantities to be inserted accordingly by them on the "Checklist for Documents" (Annex 4A-4C). This form should be submitted to MES in 2 copies.

4. Cambridge International – MS1 Marksheet:

- Educators are requested to follow the instructions as per 'Instructions to complete MS1 Mark Sheet' herewith attached to complete the enclosed 'MS1' provided by Cambridge International. Completed 'Form' (filled/signed accordingly, bearing the seal of school) should be submitted to MES in two hard copies along with the projects. NO changes should be made to the 'MS1' format.
- <u>Soft copy</u> of the 'MS1' Mark Sheet should be filled in electronically (*not to be filled in writing*) and forwarded to MES, Cambridge Examinations Section on the following email address: cs.cie.section@mesonline.mu
- 5. Extract from Cambridge International for authenticating and supervising coursework is at *Annex 5*. To avoid plagiarism, which is a case of malpractice, Educators should consult Cambridge International website and be aware of the content.
- 6. Specification for filmed video evidence, as recommended by Cambridge International, is at *Annex* 6.
- 7. Criteria for sampling for each PSN should be as at *Annex* 7. The sampling exercise should be carried out by the Educator.
- 8. Educators <u>must</u> refer to "Important Information for Teachers of Physical Education" at Annex 8 to ensure that the sample coursework to be submitted is as per Cambridge International requirements. The Mauritius Examinations Syndicate will carry out the uploading of documents/videos on the Cambridge International "Submit for Assessment" platform on behalf of schools.
- 9. It is imperative that the Educator for Physical Education follows the Cambridge syllabi, Coursework Guidelines and Handbook to ensure successful completion of the coursework and submission process.
