

## MAURITIUS EXAMINATIONS SYNDICATE NCE ASSESSMENT 2023 – FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

QUERY	RESPONSE
How is Grade Aggregate calculated?	Grade Aggregate is the sum total of numerical grades obtained in the best <b>eight (8)</b> core subjects, including English, French and Mathematics.
I obtained good results but was not allocated an Academy.	Admission to Grade 10 in an Academy is determined on the basis of the Grade Aggregate and relative performance of the eligible candidate in the best eight core subjects, including English, French and Mathematics and the choice of academy of the Responsible Party.
I obtained good results but was not allocated my first choice of Academy.	
I performed well and obtained good results but did not apply for an Academy. Can I still apply for an Academy?	Application for admission to an Academy should have been filled prior to the assessment.
What are the conditions for satisfying the requirement of NCE?	Candidates must achieve the following minimum requirement –
	Either
	Numerical grade 6 in <b>six</b> core subjects including English, French and Mathematics and at least Intermediate Level in <b>two</b> non-core subjects
	Or
	Numerical grade 6 in <b>seven</b> core subjects including English, French and Mathematics and at least Intermediate Level in <b>one</b> non-core subject
	Or
	Numerical grade 6 in <b>eight</b> core subjects including English, French and Mathematics
I am not satisfied with my results, (overall or in a particular subject). What can I do? What are the dates of receipt of requests for remarking?	Request for review of scripts should be made at the MES from <b>04 to 08 December 2023.</b>
	Fees for remarking: Rs 192 per subject.
When will I know the outcome of a review/remarking?	Candidates will be informed of outcome of review exercise before resumption of school.
