- Candidates who wish to enter for the above examinations and those <u>who have already submitted</u> <u>entries</u> should call at the Mauritius Examinations Syndicate on the above mentioned dates.
- 3. Candidates should call **in person** at the Mauritius Examinations Syndicate to fill in the Entry Form and pay the appropriate fees. Entry Forms forwarded by post will **not** be considered.
- 4. Candidates are advised to consult the list of subjects offered to **Private candidates** and the respective syllabuses before making their entry.
- 5. The fees payable are as follows:

6. Candidates who are <u>18 or above</u> should bring along their National Identity Card and original A4 format Birth Certificate.

Candidates who are **under 18 years** and who do not have the School Bus Pass should produce the following documents on the above dates:

- (i) The new A4 Birth Certificate (with NIC) and
- (ii) Two **recent** passport-size photographs bearing their name and signature and countersigned by an authorised person as listed on the web notice.
- **Either** The MES Candidate Identity/Admission Card <u>or</u> the NTA Student Identity Card together with one recent passport-size photograph bearing their name and signature;
 - **Or** Two recent passport-size photographs bearing their name and signature and countersigned by one person who has known them personally for at least two years and who is either Member of the National Assembly, Medical Practitioner, Barrister-at-Law, Attorney-at-Law, Notary Public, Bank Manager, Principal of a recognised Educational Institution, Police Officer <u>not</u> below the rank of Assistant Superintendent or Officer in the public service <u>not</u> below the rank of Assistant Secretary.

The person countersigning the photographs should give his/her own particulars as follows:

- 7. Candidates are strongly advised to be very careful while filling in their Entry Forms as an additional fee will be charged for any amendment made **after 04 March 2022.**
- 8. Very Important Notice:
