## NATIONAL CERTIFICATE OF EDUCATION (NCE) ASSESSMENT 2024 RECEIPT OF ENTRIES FOR PRIVATE CANDIDATES

- 1 Entries from Private Candidates for the above assessment will be received at the Mauritius Examinations Syndicate, Reduit as from **Monday 22 April** to **Friday 26 April 2024** during office hours (09 00 to 15 30).
- 2 Candidates should call in person at the Mauritius Examinations Syndicate, Reduit to fill in the entry forms.

### 3 Entry Requirements

- (a) A candidate, aged 17 or above, who is not attending a duly registered public or private secondary school may enter for the NCE assessment as a private candidate.
- (b) A candidate below the age of 17 who is attending a duly registered public or private secondary school and has completed the nine years of continuous basic education and has sat for the NCE assessment in the previous school year may enter for the NCE assessment as a private candidate.

Such candidate (*below the age of 17 or a second sitting below the age of 17*)) should provide evidence/details of schooling for having completed the nine years of continuous basic education (PSAC – 6 years and a certifying letter from Head of Secondary School – 3 years) or a copy of statement of results for the previous NCE assessment in order to approve his/her request for registration.

### 4 Documents Required

- (a) Candidates who are 18 years or above should produce their National Identity Card and original A4 Birth Certificate.
- (b) Prospective candidates who are below 18 years should produce the following documents:
  - original birth certificate (with NID number)
  - recent passport-size photographs for their MES Candidate Identity Card as proof of identity

#### either

the NTA Student Identity Card together with **one recent passport-size photograph** (4 ½ cm x 5 cm) bearing their name and signature

<u>or</u>

**two recent passport-size photographs** (4 ½ cm x 5 cm) bearing their name/signature and **countersigned** by one person who has known them personally for at least two years and who is either Member of the National Assembly, Medical Practitioner, Barrister-at-Law, Attorney-at-Law, Notary Public, Bank Manager, Principal of a recognized Educational Institution, Police Officer **not** below the rank of Assistant Superintendent or Officer in the Public Service **not** below the rank of Assistant Secretary.

The person countersigning the photographs should give his/her own particulars as follows: "Name, Designation, Signature".

#### 7 Access arrangements

Candidates who suffer from permanent/long-term impairment or a temporary impairment may apply for <u>access arrangement</u> on the prescribed Form NCE/S3P available at the MES and the duly filled-in form along with original Medical Certificate must be returned to NCE Section by Friday 10 May 2024 at latest. Such request should be made prior to the conduct of the assessment and should be supported by <u>a recent original Medical Certificate from a Government Medical Officer</u> specifying the nature of assistance required.

- Any request for amendment of entry should be forwarded by email to <u>ncesection@mesonline.mu</u> at latest by Friday 28 June 2024.
- 9 **Pre-released materials for Art & Design (Component 1)** will be made available to all candidates four weeks prior to the assessment date. Candidates will be informed by registered post of the date for collection.
- 10 **Final Timetable** will be issued individually to private candidates by registered post three weeks prior to the start of the assessment
