CAMBRIDGE MAY/JUNE 2026 EXAMINATION MATHEMATICS LEAKAGE PAPERS 9709/12, 9709/52

The June 2026 A Level Mathematics Paper 12 (9709) taken in Africa, Europe, Middle East, Pakistan and South Asia regions was shared prematurely against Cambridge regulations. For the June series, Mauritius/Rodrigues has a total of 448 candidates taking this syllabus.

Cambridge priority is to ensure that students are not disadvantaged by this incident and Cambridge continues to take all possible measures to protect the integrity of examinations. It is important that candidates continue to prepare for, and take, upcoming examinations.

Cambridge is therefore cancelling Paper 9709/12 held on Wednesday 29 April 2026, and it will not be used to generate results through calculated assessment. Cambridge will be issuing a replacement paper to be sat on Tuesday 9 June 2026.

Cambridge encourages all students to continue focusing on their exams, and Cambridge would like to assure them that the actions being taken are in the best interest of Cambridge students.

A replacement paper will ensure fair outcomes for all students and will deliver grades that are trusted by universities and other stakeholders. This approach aligns with the wishes of many school leaders who Cambridge has talked to. Cambridge is committed to making the replacement exam process as straightforward as possible and will not incur an additional charge for students.

You may wish to be informed that Cambridge has informed the Mauritius Examinations Syndicate, that Paper 9709/52 Mathematics held on Tuesday 12 May 2026 appears to have been compromised.

We are hereby awaiting further update from Cambridge for the next step to be followed for Mathematics Paper 9709/52.

The papers have been compromised in other countries and Cambridge is reviewing their security procedures to maintain the integrity of examinations internationally.
