CAMBRIDGE MAY/JUNE 2026 EXAMINATION MATHEMATICS PAPERS 9709/12, 9709/32, 9709/52

Cambridge International Education ensures that students are not disadvantaged by the wilful malpractice of a few due to leakage in the above papers.

1. Cambridge has taken the decision that a new version of the examination papers should be sat for Papers 9709/12 and 9709/32 by all candidates. A replacement paper will ensure fair outcomes for all students and will deliver grades that are trusted by Universities and other stakeholders.

The replacement papers are scheduled as follows:

9709/32	Monday 08 June 2026 at 13 30 hours
9709/12	Tuesday 09 June 2026 at 13 30 hours

All candidates who have entered for paper 9709 Mathematics should sit for **both Papers** and **be present** at their respective centres at 12 45 hours.

2. **9709/52 Mathematics**

For paper 52, Cambridge will use its well-established approach of ‘**assessed marks**’ to make sure students are treated equally and fairly. Universities accept and trust results that use assessed marks.

Cambridge reassures students that rigorous security protocols govern every step of how examination papers are produced, handled, stored and distributed. These measures are constantly updated as the types of malpractice threats change and have been adapted further in light of this incident.
